Mor Sobol holds a B.A in Government, Diplomacy, and Strategy from the Interdisciplinary Center (Israel), an M.A in European Studies from Hochschule Bremen (Germany), and a PhD in Politics from the University of Edinburgh (UK). Dr .Sobol held the position of a Postdoctoral Fellow at the Institute of European & American Studies at Academia Sinica, and nowadays, he works as an Adjunct Assistant Professor at Yuan Ze and Ming Chuan Universities, as well as an Affiliated Research Fellow of European Union Centre in Taiwan (EUTW). His main research interests center on international relations and security, European/Chinese/Russian foreign policy, European Union, Mediterranean politics, Taiwan/China – Israel relations, and institutionalist theories.
